Property damage possible, scattered power outages, blowing dust, hazardous travel, high fire danger


Key Messages

- → Prepare for strong, damaging winds Today
- → Impacts may include:
 - **♦** Broken tree limbs/falling trees
 - Scattered power outages
 - Property damage possible
 - Fences/shingles
 - High fire danger
 - Hazardous travel
 - Blowing dust & poor visibility

NEW

Important Notes

- → Avoid travel today
- → No burning or any outdoor activity that may produce a spark
- → Avoid parking under/near trees
- → Move unsecured decorations and patio furniture indoors
- Avoid ladders/window washing

Damaging Winds Likely

Forecast Confidence Levels and Peak Wind Gusts Expected

Initial blast of strong winds spreads across foothills and plains between 7 and 10 am. Peak wind event late morning through this afternoon

Widespread gusts 55-70 mph, but a few locations in/near the foothills could see gusts near 100 mph!




Peak Wind Gust Forecast Today

Rapid Wildfire Spread Possible






Snow & Blowing Snow Mountains

Overview

- → Burst of moderate to heavy snow likely between 5 and 8 am this morning
- → Possible Snow Squall conditions with near zero visibility/flash freeze with a narrow band of heavier snow
- → Snow and areas of blowing/drifting snow, and poor visibility into Wed afternoon
- Snow ends by early evening Wednesday



Expected Snow Accumulations





High Winds, Fire Danger, & Winter Weather

Wednesday morning to Wednesday evening



Hazards (Multiple) Property damage, broken tree limbs and scattered power outages, hazardous travel, blowing dust & poor visibility, high fire danger/rapid wildfire spread



Areas Impacted: Foothills, I-25 Corridor, and all of the Colorado Plains for winds. Mountains for snow & blowing snow. Fire danger foothills and plains.



Timing & Duration: Snow begins this morning, highest winds expected mid/late morning through the afternoon. Winds decrease rather quickly this evening.



Certainty & Considerations:

High forecast confidence of strong winds. Some threat of 100 mph winds in/near the base of the foothills!
