#### **Warning Details**




Winter Storm Warning in effect for north central mountains near Rabbit Ears Pass and I-70 Mountain Corridor until 12 PM Thursday; Northern and Northeast Plains til 3 am Thurs

Winter Weather Advisory in effect for parts of the valleys until 12 PM Thursday, I-25 Urban Corridor & eastern plains until 3 am Thursday.

Wind Chill Advisory in effect for parts of the eastern plains 11 PM Wednesday to 8 AM Thursday morning.



### **Cold Wind Chills**

### **Key Points:**

A Wind Chill Advisory is in effect for parts of the eastern plains starting 11 PM Wednesday until 8 AM Thursday morning.




The combination of wind and cold temperatures will create dangerously low wind chill values.

### **Impacts:**



Exposed skin may become quickly frostbitten or frozen. The dangerously cold wind chills could cause frostbite on exposed skin in as little as 30 minutes.
