Warning Details




Winter Storm Warning in effect for north central mountains near Rabbit Ears Pass and I-70 Mountain Corridor until 12 PM Thursday.

Winter Weather Advisory in effect for parts of the valleys until 12 PM Thursday & parts of the eastern plains until 3 AM Thursday.

Wind Chill Advisory in effect for parts of the eastern plains 11 PM Wednesday to 8 AM Thursday morning.

Quick Forecast

- Moderate snowfall will continue in the mountains through Thursday evening. Total accumulations of 12-36" along the northwestern peaks near Park, Front and Gore Ranges. 8-16" over the I-70 Mountain Corridor.
- Plains and urban corridor will receive light snowfall Wednesday afternoon and night with 1 to 4 inches possible.



Cold Wind Chills

Key Points:

A Wind Chill Advisory is in effect for parts of the eastern plains starting 11 PM Wednesday until 8 AM Thursday morning.




The combination of wind and cold temperatures will create dangerously low wind chill values.

Impacts:



Exposed skin may become quickly frostbitten or frozen. The dangerously cold wind chills could cause frostbite on exposed skin in as little as 30 minutes.

The hazard matrix depicts timing and magnitude of potential impacts to local travel and infrastructure from snowfall rates and/or amounts, blowing snow, ice, and cold temperatures.

Potential aggravating factors such as time of day, pre-existing conditions, and holiday travel periods are also taken into consideration.
