

## Flash Flooding Possible Today


#### Heavy Rain Likely across the High Country this afternoon and evening

#### **Key Messages**

- → Widespread thunderstorms will develop over the higher elevations this afternoon through evening
- → Elevated threat of flash flooding with heavy rainfall and slow moving storms
- → Flash flooding threat includes the Cameron Peak, East Troublesome, Williams Fork, and Calwood burn area

## **Important Updates**

→ Flash Flood Watch now begins at 11am since storms will form around that time

#### **This Afternoon & Evening**

#### **Watch Details**



In effect from 11 AM to 9 PM this evening.




Heavy rainfall is likely across the high country with flash flooding possible, especially over burn areas.

#### **Hazards**



Rainfall Rates of **1-1.5 inches per hour** possible

Multiple rounds of rainfall also possible through this evening






Stay informed of the weather through late this evening.

# 3 SIMPLE STEPS FOR FLASH FLOOD SAFETY

During a flood, water levels and the rate the water is flowing can quickly change. Remain aware and monitor local radio and television.





- 1 GET TO HIGHER GROUND
  Get out of the areas subject to
  Flooding
- DO NOT DRIVE INTO WATER
  Do NOT drive or walk into
  flooded areas. It only takes 6"
  of water to knock you off your
  feet.
- STAY INFORMED

  Monitor local radar, television,
  weather radio, internet or
  social media for updates.
