Flash Flood Prediction Program

MESSAGES WILL BE ALLOWED TO EXPIRE AT 10:00PM

- Message 1's issued for the entire District will be allowed to expire at 10:00pm, as the threat for heavy rainfall has come to an end.
- Scattered showers and thunderstorms impacted portions of the District this evening, producing moderate to locally-heavy rainfall. Heavy storm activity has transitioned N and E of the District at this hour, but a few stray showers and isolated thunderstorms remain possible through about midnight.
- With the loss of daytime heating and departing large-scale forcing, only light to briefly moderate rainfall is expected with tonight's additional showers and storms.

STORM RAINFALL POTENTIAL AND DURATION: Showers and thunderstorms will produce rainfall totals between 0.10-0.35" in 10-30 minutes.

WORST CASE SCENARIO: Training or back-building of strong storm cells results in rainfall up to 0.90" in 30-60 minutes.
